



## WELCOME TO ROCKPORT

On behalf of the **Town of Rockport and Cape Ann Transportation Authority**, we would like to welcome you to Rockport and hope you enjoy your visit.

- The Parking Lot will be open **seven days a week beginning** Friday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, through Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. and then it will be open Saturday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, Sunday, September 5<sup>th</sup> and Monday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day and weekends only from Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup> through Sunday, September 26<sup>th</sup>. In October, it will operate on Saturday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, **Rockport Harvest Festival Day**. The hours of operation are from 11:00 AM to 7:00 PM. **NOTE: The trolley does not operate Monday through Friday between 2:30 PM and 3:00 PM.**

- **NOTE – Additional Service:**

**On Fridays and Saturdays during the months of July and August, the lot will be open from 11:00AM to 8:00PM.**

**On July 4<sup>th</sup> and on August 14<sup>th</sup>, the lot will be open from 11:00AM to 11:00PM.**

- All parking is **Free**. The lot has 199 parking spaces and 6 handicapped parking spaces.
- The Shuttle Fee is \$1.00 per person. For seniors, anyone 60 and over, handicapped, and Medicare cardholders, the Shuttle is \$.50 per person. Children **under 5 are free** to ride. **Drivers do not make change**. Please make every effort to have the exact change ready when boarding the Trolley/Bus.
- The Trolley/Bus runs approximately every 20-25 minutes and will drop you off downtown in Dock Square. The drop off site is also the site you will use to return to the Parking Lot.
- The **last** Shuttle bus pickup is indicated above on the dates listed, so please plan your schedule accordingly to return to the Parking Lot before the **Lot closes**.
- Restroom facilities are provided for visitors use. There is no eating, drinking, or smoking on the Trolley/Bus. Furthermore, no animals can be transported unless they are **service animals or caged**.
- Neither the Town of Rockport nor Cape Ann Transportation Authority is responsible for damage to your auto or its contents.
